Her TV credits have included 'Coronation Street', 'Sea View', 'Jossy's Giants' and many more. She has been a voiceover on 'World in Action', 'All Our Yesterdays' and on Channel 4's 'Dispatches'.

Extensive radio work includes many plays and documentaries. Delia was the regular female voiceover for 'What the Papers Say' and 'On This Day' BBC Radio's six-days-a-week archive programme.
